


How to use Safe Exam Browser in Quiz (Students)

1. Login to your LMS account and go to the course in which the quiz is due.





6. Once your “Safe Exam Browser” is downloaded and installed in your system go to your quiz and now click on “Download Configuration”





7. Once the configuration is downloaded you need to click on it and run that file.




8. Once you run that file your safe exam browser will open and you will have to login to your LMS account on that browser. Once you logged in it will automatically lead you to the quiz that you are trying to attempt, and click on "Attempt Quiz" button.



9. Now click on “Start attempt” button.




10. Attempt your quiz and once you are on the last question there will be a button “Finish attempt” click on that button.


