Introduction

If you want to use the content from a course you previously developed, you can back up that course and restore the course content to another course, by using the Backup and Restore feature on LMS.

How to use the "Backup & Download" module on LMS:

Step 1:

Open the course on LMS which you would like to backup. Select "Backup" in the Settings block to start the Backup process as shown in the screenshot below:



according to your requirement.


Step 3
